A.6. General Project Description

Site: 10 Sabina Circle, Leicester Applicant: David & Joanne Kennedy Assessor's Map 48 Parcel C3.8

The applicants propose to widen their existing driveway and construct an addition within the 100-foot buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland. Also proposed are 2 C100 Cultec units to infiltrate the roof runoff. The project does not encroach into the Leicester Conservation Commission 25' no disturbance zone.

Glenn E. Krevosky of EBT Environmental Consultants, Inc. delineated the wetland boundaries in August 2021 with 9 A series wetland flags - utilizing soils, vegetation and indicators of hydrology according to 310 CMR 10.55 (2) (c).

The erosion control measures of 8" straw wattles backed by entrenched silt fence shown on the Site Plan shall be placed prior to site work. These measures shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.






