No signed or stamped plans were attached to order 197-295, so I've checked "No" to question 6. However, since the order was issued 18 years ago, I want to provide some context.

This order of conditions related to an environmental cleanup of a waste site at 11 Hankey Street. The site consisted of a sludge lagoon and effluent lagoons that were the result of plating and waste treatment operations at the plant from 1953 to 1989.

A "Phase II Comprehensive Site Assessment" was completed in March 2002, and we went before the Conservation Commission and received the go-ahead for cleanup in the order of conditions 197-295 in September. In accordance with the order, we installed hay bales and siltation fencing between the work site and the French River (some of which remains). Supervised Site remediation began in October 2002, under the direction of CMG Environmental (Ben Gould, LSP). Extensive excavation was done, with removed material going to secure landfills such as Stablex in Canada. The area was regraded and is now a meadow. Containers were kept on pavement, well away from the river, so there was no runoff. Project work was completed in November 2002.

Since then, we have done groundwater monitoring, first on a semi-annual, and now an annual basis.
