A.6. General Project Description

Site: 211 Baldwin Street, Leicester

Applicant: James Mercier

The applicant proposes to remove 17 trees in the existing beach area, 5 are within the 25-foot buffer zone and 2 White Pines are directly on the wetland line. The applicant is seeking more sunlight in the beach area. No stumps will be removed under this Notice of Intent and no trees shall be felled onto the reservoir. Under the Leicester Wetland Bylaw, the applicant is seeking a waiver from work in the 25' zone. Two White Pines proposed to be removed are shading the wetland resource area between WF 3A and WF 4A.

Glenn E. Krevosky of EBT Environmental Consultants, Inc. delineated the wetland boundaries in September 2019 with 10 A series wetland flags - utilizing soils, vegetation and indicators of hydrology according to 310 CMR 10.55 (2) (c).

The erosion control measure of 9" straw wattles shown on the Site Plan shall be placed prior to site work. This measure shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.




