### A.6. General Project Description

Site: 31 Fairview Drive, Leicester Applicant: John & Julie Ajemian Assessor's Map 41A Parcel A16

The Applicant proposes to repair with new the existing non-conforming Title V septic system within the existing lawn to the east of the existing house. At its closest point the proposed septic system is 37' from the delineated wetland line. The associated grading for the septic is 16' from the delineated line. The existing septic system shall be abandoned according to Title V requirements.

The applicant is also proposing to repair the stone and railroad tie retaining wall with a new concrete wall in the exact same location and height as the existing wall, when the lake is in its drawn down condition (see attached exhibit 8A). If dewatering of the trench, where the footing of the proposed retaining wall is to be constructed, is required, an above ground 10' diameter settling sump constructed of double staked haybales lined with an entrenched silt fence shall be installed upgradient of WFs 5A and 6A.

Glenn E. Krevosky of EBT Environmental Consultants, Inc. delineated the wetland boundaries on 6/26/17 with 7 A series wetland flags - utilizing soils, vegetation and indicators of hydrology according to 310 CMR 10.55 (2) (c).

The erosion control measure of double-staked straw wattles, shown on the Site Plan, shall be placed prior to site work. This measure shall be maintained in good working order throughout the project until all exposed soils are final graded, loamed, seeded and stabilized with well-established soil stabilizing vegetation.




