Worcester Regional Airport, Tree Clearing and Vegetation Management Plan

**Dear Commission Members:** 

Enclosed please two Requests for Certificate of Compliance for Orders of Conditions issued by the Leicester Conservation Commission to the Massachusetts Port Authority (Massport) for work conducted at the Worcester Regional Airport.

The first Order of Conditions, issued under **DEP File No. 349-1916** on June 16, 2011, covered work consisting of cutting a total of approximately 105 trees that were penetrating, or within 5 feet of penetrating, protected airspace surfaces associated with the Runway 11 Approach. Removal of these trees was required in order for the airport to comply with FAA regulations.

The second Order of Conditions covered the 5-year Vegetation Management Plan (VMP) for the airport and was issued under **DEP File No. 197-0540** on November 8, 2011. As indicated in the second Request for Certificate of Compliance, this Order of Conditions was amended on January 17, 2013 and December 21, 2015. The amendments were issued to permit additional vegetation removal needed to clear airspace surfaces.

Massport recently filed a Notice of Intent (NOI) for the 2020 VMP Update for the airport which is currently under review by the Commission. The updated VMP and NOI identify new Vegetation Management Areas (VMAs) and provide the delineation of wetland areas where vegetation clearing will occur. We would like to review the Requests for Certificate of Compliance during the next Commission hearing, along with reviewing the 2020 VMP Update.
