Enclosed please find two (2) copies of a Request for Determination of Applicability ("RDA") and Pilot Test System Layout plan submitted on behalf of the Applicant: Adam Last, PE of Corporate Environmental Advisors, Inc. This RDA is filed under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Leicester Wetland Bylaw for the above-referenced property. This filing comprises:

A copy of this filing has been submitted by certified mail, return receipt requested to the Central Regional Office of the Department of Environmental Protection and to the property owner, as required.

The proposed project consists of additional remediation/clean-up of groundwater at the former Fournier-Gemme Lagoon site. As the Commission is aware, clean-up activities were last undertaken, at this site in 2008 and 2009, under an Order of Conditions issued for DEP file #197-499. The clean-up activities currently proposed consist of injecting a non-toxic, aqueous suspension of activated carbon into proposed wells within the buffer zone and into an existing well within the wetland. No wetland impacts are proposed and the location of access points, a staging area, existing and proposed wells and temporary control measures are depicted on the attached plan. A fact sheet pertaining to the "Plume Stop" activated carbon to be used is attached to this cover letter. Additional information on this product is available upon request.
