Enclosed please find a completed WPA Form 8A - Request for Certificate of Compliance for an Order of Conditions issued by the Leicester Conservation Commission to the Massachusetts Port Authority (Massport) for work conducted at the Worcester Regional Airport.

The Order of Conditions was issued on January 6, 2011 under **DEP File No. 197-0533**. The work approved in the Order included removal of a beaver dam, consisting of approximately 50 cubic yards of wood debris and soil, from a culvert headwall located on Lynde Brook.

I prepared the plans submitted with the Notice of Intent (NOI) for the subject work, and I oversaw the removal of the beaver dam described in the NOI. The work was completed in substantial compliance with the plans approved in the Order of Conditions.
