1. **Request for Certificate of Compliance:** Mulberry Solar (DEP# 197-0636), Applicant: Devin Howe

Mr. Howe displays a plan showing where field stabilization is needed. The Commission agrees to continue the request until the site work is completed. Mr. Howe should contact the Commission when said site work is finished.

2. Request for Determination of Applicability

a) 1 & 3 Paxton (RDA2021-05), Minor Plan Change, Applicant: Town of Leicester.

Mr. Boucher explains the plan modifications include moving the water discharge point and removal of the previously proposed sump pump. The plan was previously approved with a Negative 3 determination on April 14, 2021.

Motion: Ms. Schold moves to approve the minor plan changes to 1 & 3 Paxton St as proposed.

Second: Ms. Marttila Discussion: None Vote: (3-0-1)

[Note: Mr. Cooper abstained from voting.]

b) 57 Fairview Drive (RDA2021-07), Applicant: Raymond Gaulin. (yard and driveway improvements)

Mr. Gaulin filed the RDA as a formality per the Commissions request following a complaint about work being done on his property.

Motion: Ms. Schold moves to approve the RDA at 67 Lakeview Dr with a Negative 3 determination.

Second: Ms. Marttila Discussion: None Vote: (4-0-0)

c) Marshall St/Paxton St Intersection (RDA2021-08), Applicant: Leicester Highway Department. (intersection improvements)

Dennis Griffin, Highway Superintendent, explains the RDA application is to make needed improvements to the intersection which include adding 12' of pavement, adding a catch basin and removing four dead trees. The site will be lined with wattles to protect the Kettle Brook Reservoir. All the work is projected to be finished this year.

Motion: Ms. Schold moves to approve the project with a negative 3 determination with wattles lining the site as noted in the meeting.

d) Craig Street (RDA2021-09), Applicant: Leicester Highway Department. (catch basin replacement)

Mr. Griffin plans to replace two failing catch basins and the connected pipes across the street from each other on Craig Street.

Motion: Mr. Cooper moves to approve the RDA with a negative 3 determination.

Second: Ms. Marttila Discussion: None Vote: (4-0-0)

e) 209 Greenville St (RDA2021-10), Applicant: Samantha Butkiewicks. (10x20 gazebo construction on waterfront.)

Ms. Butkiewicks plans to build a 10'x20' gazebo within 20' of the water. Ms. Schold visited the site and recommended that Ms. Butkiewicks file an RDA because the area was previously disturbed.

Motion: Ms. Schold moves to approve the RDA at 209 Greenville St with a Negative 3 determination.

Second: Mr. Cooper

Discussion: Ms. Butkiewicks is to let the Commission know when work starts so the

Commission can recommend where wattles should be placed.

3. Notice of Intent

[Note: 0 Chapel St and 31 Chapel St were continued to the next meeting because DEP has not yet issued DEP numbers.]

208 Rawson St (DEP# 197-0664), Applicant: Sparhawk Realty LLC. (single-family home construction and associated site work)

Scott Morrison with EcoTec says the house previously on this site was torn down and the applicant is proposing a new single-family home and septic system. There are bordering vegetated wetlands to the north and northeast, but straw wattles will be placed and serve as the limit of work. The area between the deck and the 25' buffer is previously disturbed. The proposed new septic system will be at the front of the property.

Maureen Doyle of 210 Rawson St asks if all the brush will be cleared off the property. Mr. Morrison will ask the owner to clear the brush along the property lines.

Motion: Ms. Schold moves to approve the NOI at 208 Rawson St with the hay bale wattle line as shown on the plan.

Second: Mr. Cooper

Discussion: The applicant should notify the Commission when work starts and post the DEP number on site within 48 hours.

[Note: 25 Auburn St/Kettle Brook, River St/Greenville Pond, 59 Burncoat Lane were continued to the next meeting because DEP has not yet issued DEP numbers.]

[Note: The applicant for 67 Lakeview Dr RDA arrived late to the meeting.]

67 Lakeview Dr (RDA2021-11) Applicant: Jeffrey Gervais. (shallow well replacement)

This RDA was heard at the May 12 meeting, but the Commission noted there was a well replacement on the plan that wasn't on the WPA form 1. The Commission asked the applicant to return with a revised project description in order to approve the well replacement.

Motion: Ms. Schold moves to approve the RDA at 67 Lakeview Dr with a Negative 3 determination.

Second: Mr. Cooper **Discussion:** None **Vote:** (4-0-0)

4. Board Discussion/Miscellaneous

a) Environmental Notification Form, 1603-1605 Main Street (gas station, fast-food restaurant, convenience store)

This project exceeds certain thresholds so the applicants must file an ENF prior to filing individual permits with Leicester's Conservation and Planning Boards.

b) Forestry Plan, Parker St. Applicant: Schold Development LLC.

The Forestry Plan on Parker St was approved by DCR prior to this meeting. The Commission asks Ms. Buck to make DCR aware of the Definitive Subdivision Plan proposed for Parker St, as Forestry Plans cannot be approved if there are active applications for the same site. Ms. Schold (who recused herself as a Commission member on this topic but is speaking as a Leicester resident) says the forest cutting is taking place across the street from the proposed Definitive Subdivision Plan.

Complaint dropped due to insufficient evidence that leaves were blocking the stream behind neighbor's house.

453 Rawson

No update. A Commission member will try to visit the site ASAP.
