Mr. Parliment reviewed the Commission's continuing effort to bring public awareness on the Moose Hill Reservoir Project.

He invited Mr. Peter Swanson to this meeting to show a documentary he put together on a project called "Water Reuse for Drinking". This successful project is used throughout the World and puts 80% of wastewater back into useable drinking water.

The presentation demonstrated this project is being used in several countries, as well as in the U.S. Mr. Swanson noted Grant money was available to communities interested.

The closest area to New England was located in the State of Virginia. Some other states were California, Colorado, Georgia and Texas and some of the countries were Belgium, Singapore, Australia and Namibia.
