The following information addresses the process used to identify a not-to-exceed limit for the Designer Services RFQ for Borger Hall, Knight Hall, Swan Library, and the Lenfest Animal Clinic.

Recommendation.

Establish a "not-to exceed limit" of \$300,000 for the Designer Services up to the Design Development Phase.

Calculations.

Establishing "not-to-exceed" limit for Designer Services RFQ. The Design fee is calculated as a percentage of Fixed Limit Construction Cost (FLCC) based on the complexity of the project. The intent of the feasibility study is to develop project construction cost estimates. We do not currently have estimates for most of the construction costs.

Rough estimates received for Borger Hall were used to estimate the costs of similar projects on the other three buildings. These costs were paired down to reflect projects most likely to be advanced to the construction phase in the near term. The estimated FLCC is \$3,265,000. Assuming a DCAMM Project Category of Group II, the design fee would equal approximately 9.3% of FLCC or \$303,645.
