Highlights/Outreach

SUMMER IS UPON US AND SO IS THE HEAT!!!



For seniors, **MEMA** advises the following: Slow down, avoid strenuous activity. Don't do too much during hottest hours of the day. Drink plenty of water even if you don't feel thirsty. Limit intake of alcoholic beverages that dehydrate. Eat well-balanced light meals. Avoid high protein foods. Stay indoors. Wear lightweight, loose fitting clothing. Light colors will reflect heat and help maintain normal body temperatures. Protect your face with a wide-brimmed hat. If you don't have air conditioning, stay on the lowest floor. Electric fans do not cool the air, but do help evaporate sweat which cools off the body. Go to a place where you can get relief from the heat, such as air conditioned schools, libraries, theaters, other community facilities that may offer refuge during hottest part of the day. Avoid too much sunshine. Sunburn slows the skin's ability to cool. If you are outside, use sunscreen lotion with a high SPF (Sun Protection Factor) rating. Check on family, friends, neighbors. 
