#### WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY

There may be times, though rarely, that we may close the senior center. If freezing rain is forecast the center will close even if schools are open.

Though we normally close our center only when local schools are closed, we may have to be prudent and close a center dedicated to a senior population who could end up with broken bones if someone should slip and fall because of icy conditions. What you should know about Leicester is as follows:

Leicester has an elevation of 1,000 feet which drops the temperature from that at sea level by about 3 to 5 degrees as compared to other local towns. It could be 35 degrees in Auburn and only 30 in Leicester with sleet rather than rain. For example, on December 12, 2008 a big ice storm hit Leicester even though Auburn and south of Leicester had rain only. It is very difficult for us to make such decisions. We do it to protect our elders. For staff it means numerous phone calls, rearranging schedules including bus scheduling, calling presenters, calling exercise programs instructors, etc. Please call if you have any questions.
