
I therefore request that the board appoint the following to Leicester EMS effective immediately:



Waite Pond Dam Wall Extension, Leicester, Massachusetts

This memorandum provides information regarding the recommended approach to extend the retaining wall (i.e., "training wall") on the right side of the spillway (when looking downstream) at the Waite Pond Dam. The extension is necessary to contain flow over the spillway within the channel during significant storm events. Without the extension, there is a risk that flow over the spillway may overtop the right retaining wall downstream that could lead to erosion of the downstream earthen slope of the dam. Severe erosion at the downstream side of the dam may threaten the integrity of the dam embankment and lead to a safety condition from flooding in the downstream area.




Figure 1: Existing right retaining wall

Figure 1 shows the top of the spillway is too close to the top of the downstream right retaining wall, and under a storm event, water may overtop the wall. The goal of the proposed wall extension is to contain storm flows within the spillway area and avoid overtopping and erosion of the soil next to the wall.



We evaluated three alternatives for mitigating the identified condition. These alternatives are summarized below. Alternative 1, which comprises an extension of the existing wall, is the recommended approach. This approach to extend the retaining wall will result in equivalent engineering function to other alternatives and is the least invasive alternative to address the condition, is the most expedient alternative, and is consistent with the 2018 Dam Safety Permit for the project.

Alternative 1: Wall Extension (Recommended Approach)

The proposed work involves extending the wall by chipping off one inch of concrete from the top of the existing downstream wall to receive the wall extension. The wall extension will be constructed with cast-in-place concrete with steel reinforcing bars (rebar) embedded in the concrete across the joint and waterstops embedded in the concrete to create a continuous, water-tight joint. The proposed extension is depicted in Figure 2.



The extension construction would ideally be completed during the existing seasonal pond drawdown authorized under an existing Order of Conditions from the Town of Leicester (the Town) Conservation Commission. If the construction is performed outside of that seasonal pond drawdown period, a drawdown of approximately one foot from normal level and additional authorization from the Conservation Commission may be required. Based on an estimate from the project's Contractor, the installation of the extension is anticipated to be require approximately two (2) weeks to complete. Implementing this alternative will not result in significant impacts to the residents around the pond during construction.

Several types of joints are routinely introduced into concrete for a variety of reasons during construction of concrete structures. There are joints present in the concrete at the Waite Pond Dam spillway. The proposed joint is designed by structural engineers to contain sufficient and properly configured rebar so that the concrete is functionally equivalent to a monolithic structure, with the same strength, durability, and design life as the concrete around the joint. Following construction, the modified wall will have a

diagonal construction joint between the existing wall and the wall extension. Unlike the existing joints in the spillway and walls, the proposed wall extension joint will not be subject to continuous loading from water and soil that would stress the wall.

Alternative 2: Extensive Wall Replacement

The extensive wall replacement involves removing the downstream portion of the existing wall to the nearest upstream joint, which would require removal of nearly half of the existing wall (Figure 3). Since the spillway weir, stilling basin, and embankment soil were constructed around the wall, the structural elements will require significant underpinning to ensure that they are not undermined and damaged during construction. The extensive wall replacement would also require significant excavation of the soil behind the wall and replacement of the wall drain within the earthen embankment to permit the wall removal and construction activities.





Figure 4: Wall replacement alternative, the spillway and basin wall are "in front" of the wall segment subject to replacement

Figure 4 is a profile along the embankment and spillway and depicts the structures at risk during construction, including the earthen embankment, the spillway weir, a basin wall downstream of the spillway, and a buried concrete cut-off wall in the embankment. Replacement of the wall under this alternative will require new permits and a pond drawdown of approximately 10 feet during construction.

The design and permitting of the wall replacement is estimated to take approximately 18 months, and the construction is estimated to take approximately six (6) months. Ideally, construction would be completed during the summer construction season since the low flow stream conditions and temperatures are favorable to construction.





Figure 5: Profile of structural elements at risk during wall replacement

Alternative 3: Permanent Partial Pond Drawdown

A third alternative involves a permanent, partial drawdown of the pond. This alternative effectively addresses the potential overtopping condition by lowering the pond, which increases the distance between the spillway weir and the top of the wall. The permanent drawdown would be completed by removing the wooden weir boards from the top of the spillway and removing the top section of the spillway along the existing, horizontal construction joint. Under this alternative, the pond would be permanently lowered by approximately four (4) feet (Figure 5). Unlike Alternative 2, one advantage of this approach is that implementation does not pose an undue risk to the structural integrity of the wall and spillway and does not require significant and invasive excavation into the embankment soils.




Figure 6: Proposed spillway crest elevation

Unlike the other alternatives, this approach permanently alters the upstream area by converting a portion of the impounded water surface area to land area. Changing the water surface level potentially exposes an estimated 20 to 30 feet of land around the perimeter of the pond. This alternative would require new permits. The design and permitting is estimated to take approximately 12 to 18 months. The construction requires a temporary pond drawdown of approximately 10 feet, and the construction is estimated to take approximately 2 to 3 months. The construction would ideally be completed in the summertime.

Summary

Based on our analysis of the three alternatives in this memorandum, we recommend that the Town authorize the Contractor to construct the wall extension in Alternative 1 so that the work can be scheduled and expedited to minimize risks to the dam and downstream areas. Completion of the extension will be required to close out the construction project and submit record drawings to the Massachusetts Department of Conservation & Recreation Office of Dam Safety reflecting the completed project. *Table 1* summarizes each alternative presented herein.




Waite Pond Dam Proposed Wall Revision


Existing Conditions





 The Town received a bid for Borger ADA entrances after a procurement advertised in the Central Register and on Commbuys - Adams and Ruxton of West Springfield - \$47,147.79

 On the same day, we also received bids for construction of an ADA accessible bathroom at Borger. Monadnock Commercial Building Co. of Jaffrey NH won the bid. - \$123,604

We also have a bid out for the ADA handrails at Borger. That bid is due on July 10. Once these projects are completed, the first floor of the building will be ready for occupancy.

We will be installing sprinklers throughout the building next summer. We are also seeking grant funding to install an elevator during the same time frame.

RE: Recruitments

With the FY 2024 budget strategy being voted by the Board, and with the School Department being fully funded, departments have asked me what is happening with the current vacant staff positions. The positions, and the reasons for filling them are listed below:

Police (2 positions) – The Chief reports that due to one officer being out on IOD (for which is being paid for), and the two positions being vacant, he is being forced to use overtime to properly staff shifts. This is affecting the ability of staff to provide the resident with the quality service that they need, especially in situations regarding investigation.

DPW (2 Positions) – The DPW superintendent is spending significant time mowing due to the personnel shortage, It is hoped that if the Board fills these positions, we will be able to do perform mowing and snow plowing on the campus this year.

Assistant Planner - In speaking with the DIS director, he would like to have a Conservation Agent in place, as it is difficult to get the conservation work done. This position may be part time.

Assistant Town Administrator – This position is in place to keep the HR and economic development functions running. We have managed to do it, but the Administrative Assistant spends the majority of her hours paying campus bills. I have moved the Grant Writer upstairs, but I try to leave her alone as much as possible. We are functioning, but our filing is becoming problematic.
