**TOWN OF LEICESTER PUBLIC HEARING
FY 2017 CDBG Application**

The Leicester Board of Selectmen will conduct a Public Hearing on February 13, 2017 at 6:30 PM in the Selectmen's Conference Room at the Leicester Town Hall, 3 Washburn Square. The public is encouraged to attend this hearing to discuss the Town's FY 2017 application to the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development for up to \$800,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds.

The Town of Leicester is seeking public input on potential grant-funded projects. Projects in the application are expected to include: 1) housing rehabilitation assistance for eligible low-to-moderate income residents; and 2) architectural barrier removal at the Town Hall to improve access for disabled persons. These projects were identified as priorities that are consistent with Leicester's Community Development Strategy.

All persons with questions or comments regarding the grant application will have an opportunity to be heard. Those unable to attend may send written comments to the Leicester Board of Selectmen, 3 Washburn Square, Leicester, MA 01524. If awarded, the Central Massachusetts Planning Commission (CMRPC) will assist the Town with grant implementation and administration.
