WARRANT OF ANNUAL WATER DISTRICT MEETING
May 10, 2022

You are hereby directed to notify the voters of the Hillcrest Water District to meet at the St. Jude Meeting Hall 489 Pleasant Street, Leicester Massachusetts at 7:00p.m. on Tuesday May 10, 2022 to act upon the following:

Article 1. To choose a Moderator.

Article 2. To hear the reports of the District Officials.

Article 3 To elect, the following officers: One Water Commissioner for three years.

Article 4. To see if the District will raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds, a sum of money to defray the expenses of the District for the ensuing twelve months or act thereon.

Article 5. To see what compensation the District will allow its officers for the coming fiscal year or act thereon.

Article 6. To see if the District will authorize the treasurer, with the approval of the Commissioners, to borrow in anticipation of the revenue for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 in accordance with the General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 4, and Acts and Amendments therefore, and including, in addition thereto, Chapter 849 of the Acts of 1969, as amended and to renew any note or notes as may be given for a period of less than one year in accordance with the General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 17, or act thereon.

Article 7 To see whether the District will authorize the treasurer (collector) to enter into compensating balance agreement during the fiscal year 2023 as permitted by the General Laws, Chapter 44 Section 53F, or act thereon.

Article 8. To see if the District will vote to transfer a sum of money to the FY 22 Operating Budget as may be necessary to defray the expenses of the District for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 or take any action thereon

Article 9 To see if the District will vote to grant, for nominal consideration, temporary and/or permanent rights of way and/or easements to Verizon New England Inc. and Massachusetts Electric Company over and under real property owned by the District on parts Leigh Road a/k/a Pleasant Street in Leicester, more particularly described in deeds recorded in Worcester County Registry of Deeds in Book 3742, page 459 and Book 61937, Page 8, for required utility easements as needed for infrastructure in support of the Lease dated March 25, 2021 for placement of cell antennas on the District's water tank on Leigh Road, or to take any other action relative thereto.
