New Notice of Intent

20-22 Lake Dr.

I filed a new Notice of Intent yesterday electronically with the DEP for the above-referenced project since it expired, even with the COVID emergency extension, in May of this year. I paid the state share of the filing fee online electronically at the same time. I have prepared three sets of the required documents that I will hand-deliver next week when the final full-sized plans arrive.

This project was approved on February 15, 2018 for essentially the same footprint as what is currently proposed though there are some minor differences. The property has a few old out-buildings on it including an outhouse which will be removed and disposed of properly in the process of constructing the single-family home.

No work, other than implementing erosion control measures, had commenced on the previous NOI. I have submitted a Certificate of Compliance request to remove the expired Order of Conditions from the deed by indicating that the OOC has lapsed on the COC form. A silt fence and erosion control berm were installed just above the top of the bank to Burncoat Pond. The erosion control berm has some small trees growing in it since it was installed 4 years ago. The plan calls for installing new silt fence and straw wattles where the current silt fence is located. The erosion control berm can remain until the grading for the site is nearing completion at which time the berm will be graded back into the slope at the pre-existing grade, loamed and seeded.


