Progress Update:

The construction work begun on Wednesday September 6. Unfortunately, not much progress was accomplished that day due to the heavy rain. Work continues this week with the installation of new manholes and catch basins, pipes and connection to the existing drainage system.

Work started near the intersection of Hyland and Paxton St. Two police details are assisting with the traffic. Also, two message boards are placed at each end of the project.

A walk-thru meeting with National Grid is schedule for the end of this week.

Look Ahead:

Drainage work will continue next week. The contractor will be working near the Primary and High Schools installing structures and pipes. Arrangements have been made with the School Director of Facilities and school staff. Extra care will be used.

Paxton Street traffic is managed with minimum inconveniences. We will continue to take measures to proceed as smoothly as possible.
